State Voucher

- Children aged between 0 6 are eligible.
- The maximum award may cover the **entire** cost of your child's tuition.
- Eligible families earning less than 85% SMI may qualify.
- Due to limited funding, there is a waitlist at this time. Mass211 is able to screen families for eligibility and place them on the statewide centralized waitlist directly over the phone. For convenience, there is also an online application that can be submitted at any time. To apply, call 211 or fill out the application online:

- Children aged between 0 − 6 are eligible.
- Program Start and End Date: Program funding is available to support child care costs for time period: April 1, 2024 – December 31, 2024
- This subsidy may not be used in conjunction with any other childcare subsidies.
- Families will be funded on a first come, first serve basis.
- Eligible families may receive up to \$7,000 per child, though the initial award likely ranges from \$2,000-\$3,000.

Slough Farm Child Care Subsidy Program

- Children aged between 0 − 6 are eligible.
- This subsidy may not be used in conjunction with any other child care subsidies.
- Complete applications are funded on a first come, first served basis.
- The program is designed to assist families with income greater than 80% 125% of the Annual Income Range (AMI) for the funded period. See chart below.
- Eligible families may receive up to \$5,000.

Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood (MCCYN)

This is a DoD and U.S. Coast Guard fee assistance program for eligible families who cannot access military-operated child care due to distance or waitlists. With fee assistance, a portion of your child care costs is paid to offset the costs of community-based care.
